A Resolution Establishing an Ad Hoc Committee for Violence Against Women



Resolution No. 13-30



WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing over 500,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and,

WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) recognizes the devastating impact that domestic and sexual violence has on tribal communities and the need for coordinated efforts and responses to effectively address these crimes; and.



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes establishes an Ad Hoc Committee for Violence Against Women.
