A Resolution Supporting Oklahoma State Department of Health Adoption of Immunization Rule Changes

WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing approximately 750,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and

- WHEREAS, the health benefits of vaccines are well documented via rigorous research and science-based data; and
- WHEREAS, parents and guardians of children will benefit from receiving factual information on the risks and benefits of immunization based on research and science-based data; and

WHEREAS, the proposed rule changes to the Oklahoma State Department of Health Immunization Regulations, in Subchapter 1 for Childhood Immunization, Rules 310:535-1-2 and 310:535-1-3, would assure parents or guardians choosing to pursue a personal or religious exemption for their children from required immunizations in Oklahoma receive education on the importance of vaccines and vaccine safety; and

- WHEREAS, it is expected that providing education on vaccines would decrease the number of children in Oklahoma that have vaccine exemptions and increase the number of school-age children who are protected by vaccination; and
- WHEREAS, with more children fully immunized, the incidence of preventable communicable diseases in children will decrease resulting in more children being healthy and better prepared to achieve in school with improved economic prospects.

NOW, THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes supports the proposed changes to the Oklahoma State Department of Health Immunization Regulations that would modify the process for obtaining and submitting religious and personal vaccine exemptions for children enrolled in Oklahoma schools or child care centers in order to decrease the number of children not protected against communicable disease.
