## A RESOLUTION OF THE INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE FIVE CIVILIZED TRIBES No.\_\_95-05\_\_

## Request to support waiver of Performance Standard for new Tribal WIC Programs

WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which united the tribal governments of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee Nations, representing over 300,000 tribal members throughout the United States, and WHEREAS, Tribal Governments administer the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) by the authority of the Health Meals for Healthy Americans Act of 1994; and WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Consumer Services, uses a Performance Standard of 97% on food expenditures; and WHEREAS, tribes during the initial two years of the WIC Program could face difficulties in meeting this standard in food expenditures during a period of caseload development; and WHEREAS, the penalty for not meeting this 97% Performance Standard is up to a 15% reduction of total grant in the subsequent year: **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Inter-Tribal council of the Five Civilized Tribes recommends that new Tribal WIC Programs be granted a two year waiver from the 97% Performance Standard for Food Expenditures. Adopted by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes meeting at Arrowhead Resort, Canadian. OK on this  $13^{th}$  day of January, 1995 by a vote of  $\underline{24}$  for,  $\underline{0}$  against,  $\underline{0}$  abstentions.
