Resolution in support of Opposing of the Elimination of FY '96 Funding For Safe and Drug-Free School Programs

- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the tribal governments of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee nations, representing over 300,000 Indian People throughout the United States, and
- **WHEREAS**, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes recognizes the need for Opposing the Elimination of FY '96 Funding for Safe and Drug-Free School Programs; and
- **WHEREAS,** that the Safe and Drug-Free School Programs are established to reduce use/abuse of alcohol and other drugs and provides safe facilities and an environment conducive to learning; and
- **WHEREAS,** that the Federal Government as a special and continuing obligation to provide Safe and Drug-Free Programs to Serve Indian children; and
- **WHEREAS,** the rescission bill currently before the House of Representatives called for elimination of funding for the Safe and Drug-Free School Programs,
- **NOWTHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that opposition by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes to the elimination of funding for Safe and Drug-Free School Programs be made known.

Adopted by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes meeting in Washington, D.C. on this <u>7th</u>, day of **April**, **1995**, by a vote of **23** for, **0** against, and **0** abstentions.
