Opposing the Elimination of FY 96 Funding for Dropout Prevention Programs

- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the tribal governments of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee nations, representing over 300,000 Indian people throughout the United States, and
- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council recognizes the need for Dropout Demonstration Programs to serve special educational and culturally related academic needs of Indian-controlled elementary and secondary schools; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Dropout Prevention Programs are established to prevent school dropouts and reduce absenteeism; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Dropout Prevention Program has indicated success with relevant performance indicators for the student; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Federal Government has a special and continuing obligation to provide Dropout Prevention program to serve Indian Children; and
- **WHEREAS**, the rescission bill currently before the House of Representatives calls for the elimination of funding for the Dropout Prevention Program.
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the opposition by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes to the elimination of funding for the Dropout Prevention Program be made known.

Adopted by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes meeting in Washington, D.C. on this $\underline{7th}$, day of **April**, 1995, by a vote of $\underline{23}$ for, $\underline{0}$ against, and $\underline{0}$ abstentions.
