Resolution No. #95-24

Support for Senate Bill S. 904

- WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the tribal Governments of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee Nations, representing over 300,000 tribal members throughout the United States; and,
- WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council recognizes that the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) serves as an adjunct to good health care during critical times of growth and development; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council passed a resolution in January of 1995 opposing the legislation placing food assistance programs including WIC into block grants; and
- **WHEREAS,** Senator Lugar's, Chair of the Senate Agriculture Committee, has introduced Senate Bill S. 904 that ensures the WIC Program would be preserved in its entirety as a Federal Grant program.
