WHEREAS,	tribal governments of the Choctaw,	Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and 300,000 tribal members throughout the United States
WHEREAS,	the Inter-Tribal Health Committee of this organization has identified recruitment of health professionals as a major expense on health care resources; and,	
WHEREAS,	this committee has determined that it would be of mutual benefit for the five tribes to form a consortium for the recruitment and retention of health professions; and,	
WHEREAS,	the committee desires to seek funding for a demonstration project of such an Inter-Tribal Health consortium;	
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes authorizes the health committee to seek funding for the development of a demonstration project on an Inter-Tribal consortium for the recruitment and retention of health care professionals.
