A RESOLUTION OF THE INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE FIVE CIVILIZED TRIBES OF OKLAHOMA

Resolution 95-32

- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which unites the tribal governments of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee Nations, representing over 300,000 tribal members throughout the United States; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the need for modernization and new construction related funding is greater than available construction funding.
- **WHEREAS,** the tribes have the ability to perform modernization and new construction in a more efficient and cost effective manner, and
- WHEREAS, the tribes desire to initiate new processes and procedures to facilitate construction, and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes requests that Congress authorize the use of non-congressionally earmarked appropriations for program related construction.
