Resolution No. 95-38

RESOLUTION OPPOSING THE ELIMINATION OF THE TITLE I ONE PERCENT (1%) SET ASIDE FUNDS FOR BIA SCHOOLS

- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes in an organization which unites the tribal government of the Choctaw, Chickasaw, Muscogee (Creek), Seminole and Cherokee nations, representing over 300,000 Indian people throughout the United States, and
- **WHEREAS,** Title I funds are vital in supporting programs at the BIA-funded schools in meeting the basic educational needs of Indian students; and
- **WHEREAS,** the proposed elimination of BIA Title I funds would decrease funding for 21,000 students by at least #850 per student; and
- WHEREAS, the Title I BIA program has indicated success based on academic performance indicators; and
- WHEREAS, any gains in achievement scores of these Title I students are expected to decrease if funds are eliminated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the opposition by the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes to the elimination of one percent set aside for BIA Title I Programs.
