SUPPORT TRIBAL WELFARE REFORM AMENDMENT

- **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes is an organization which united the Tribal governments of the Muscogee (Creek), Seminole, Cherokee, Choctaw, and Chickasaw Nations, representing over 300,000 tribal members throughout the United States, and
- WHEREAS, Tribal governments successfully operate programs for the benefit of Indian people; and
- **WHEREAS,** the United States Senate is distributing funds through the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant,
- **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes support a welfare reform amendment which will provide tribes with a direct tribal set aside. The Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Block Grant.
