

A Resolution Supporting Efforts to Ensure Full Participation of Tribal Citizens in the 2020 Census

Resolution No. 19-20



WHEREAS, the next decennial census, mandated in Article 1, Section 2 of the U.S. Constitution, will occur on April 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the decennial census is a foundation of American democracy that is used to allocate congressional seats and electoral votes and to guarantee equal representation, so an accurate census count is necessary to ensure that Native American voters have an equal voice in the political process of non-tribal elections; and

WHEREAS, census data also plays a key role in the fair distribution of billions of dollars to tribes and Native American people across the nation, including distribution of federal funding for tribal programs that support education, health care, infrastructure, housing and economic development; and

WHEREAS, Native American people have been historically underrepresented in the census, and the Census Bureau estimates that 44.5% of Native Americans in the state of Oklahoma live in hard-to-count Census tracts; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is facing several challenges with the 2020 Census, which include declining response rates, technological change and fiscal constraints, making support from partners in local communities even more critical; and

providers, educational institutions and other community stakeholders can help ensure an accurate 2020 census count by sharing information and providing resources to assist local residents with completing the census form.
