A Resolution Recognizing the Contribution of Senator James Inhofe

Resolution No. 24-12













WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes (ITC) is an organization that unites the tribal governments of the Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Muscogee (Creek), and Seminole Nations, representing approximately 815,000 Indian people throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, as tribal nations, we exercise unique sovereign rights of self-government and continuing government-to-government relationships with the United States, founded on our distinct histories, languages, cultures and identities that have been fiercely protected against government policies intended to eradicate our existence as distinct peoples; and

WHEREAS, Senator James Inhofe represented the State of Oklahoma in the United States Senate and in the House of Representatives, and also served as Mayor of the City of Tulsa; and

WHEREAS, Senator Inhofe passed away on July 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Senator Inhofe's support of the Stigler Act Amendments benefitted many Tribal citizens to maintain allotted land in restricted status; and

WHEREAS, Sentator Inhofe was a staunch advocate of the United States armed forces and an advocate in tribal participation in the efforts to support our military; and

WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes recognizes the contributions made by Senator Inhofe to the people of the State of Oklahoma and Indian country.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT, the Inter-Tribal Council of the Five Civilized Tribes expresses its gratitude for Senator Inhofe's legacy of service and his contributions to the people of Oklagoma and extends thoughts and prayers to his family.
